## **ITINERARY**

### **Friday 10/3 -**

- **4pm-ish**, Meet & Greet at the Hotel. **Thunder Ranch** is sponsoring a happy hour poolside or in one of the hotel meeting areas (tbd)

### **Saturday 10/4 -**

- Breakfast (on your own). **800am** Meet at **Days Inn**, tune cars as necessary, **Leave at 830am**. The day's drive will **follow 89A towards Sedona**. This route follows a Nat'l Scenic Byway and will be full of amazing views and twisties. We'll stop at the mountainside mining town of **Jerome** along the way. Continue through Sedona on 89a through **Oak Creek Canyon** towards **Flagstaff** to the lookout point and the Indian Market and a turnaround point near I-17. Head back to Sedona for lunch, then return to the Hotel in Prescott Valley later on that afternoon.

**Mileage = 120 mile loop; approx time = 4 hours with lunch stop.**

- Meet back at hotel for rest, bench racing, etc. Dinner at the Historic Palace located on the historic Whiskey Row in downtown Prescott. We will have the raffle and share good times, talk spyders!

### **Sunday 10/5 -**

- Breakfast (on your own) \* **800 am** (or earlier) Leave from hotel.

Shorter drive to the west of town along **89A** through the Prescott National Forest on to Kirkland Junction. This route has more killer twisties and incredible scenery. We'll have lunch at the Bar at Kirkland Junction and then head back to town.

**Mileage = 50 mile loop; approx time = 2 hours with lunch stop.**
